## CHINESE LANGUAGE CURRICULUM SECOND CONTROL LANGUAGE LEARNING

- Pull out learning groups for S.1 to S.5.
- Adopt a school based Chinese Language curriculum and adapted learning and teaching materials.
- After school Chinese Learning Groups and Summer Bridging Courses.
- Option to study Applied Learning Chinese (ApL(C)) for HKDSE.
- Provide opportunities for NCS students to learn and interact with their Chinese - speaking peers in school.
- Provide special assessment and homework arrangements.
- Provide opportunities for NCS students to enroll in either GCSE or IGCSE courses depending on ability.



- Translate major school circulars and important matters.
